Nigel Morlet is an established Western Australian Ophthalmologist with over 20 years of experience. He subspecialises in cataract, corneal and refractive surgery, and oculoplastic surgery. Following graduating with a MB BS from the University of Western Australia his ophthalmology training was at the Prince of Wales Hospital, Sydney, gaining his Fellowship of the Royal Australian College for Ophthalmologists and Fellowship of the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons in 1994.

Further sub-specialist training in corneal and external diseases was at Moorfields Eye Hospital, London where he was a lecturer at the Institute of Ophthalmology. During that Fellowship he was awarded the Royal College of Surgeons Cutler's Prize. Returning to Perth, he was appointed as Consultant at Royal Perth Hospital and operates both at the Perth Eye Hospital and St John of God Hospital, Subiaco.

Widely published in the area of ophthalmic infections and drugs, Dr Morlet is a Clinical Professor at the School of Population Health, UWA. Prof Morlet was also one of the first Australians to be published on Excimer Laser Refractive Surgery. And since 1993, he has published over 100 papers as well as 4 patents. He also has particular research expertise in cataract instrument design, Data Linkage, and Registry population studies.
